Barone received his doctorate in Curriculum Studies and Teacher Education from Stanford University in the late 1970s. He taught courses in curriculum studies & qualitative research methods (including narrative & arts based research) for over two decades at ASU before his retirement in 2012. Barone is the author & editor of several books, including *Arts-Based Research* (2012), with Elliot Eisner. Barone is the recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award of Division B (Curriculum Studies) of the American Education Research Association, and, in 2012, the first recipient of the Tom Barone Award for Distinguished Lifetime Contributions to Arts Based Educational Research by the ABR Special Interest Group of AERA. Barone currently resides in his beloved home town of New Orleans, Louisiana.
